



SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

Women

- 1. Abayas, hijabs, under hats if you need them (optional)
- 2. Hijab pins or magnets
- 3. Leggings for underneath abaya (these are preferred so pants don't drag)
- 4. Sun cap/ visor
- 5. Light T-Shirts underneath abayas
- 6. Panty liners and menstrual pads
- 7. Razor & Shaving creams
- 8. Hair ties, Hair clips

All Hujjaj

- 1. Portable fan
- 2. Water spray bottle
- 3. Vitamins (Example: Daily Multi Vitamin, Vitamin C packets, etc) EmergenC or anything else you trust –
- 4. Medications (Prescription or Over the counter)
- 5. Hydration packets/ Electrolytes
- 6. Cough drops
- 7. Fanny pack
- 8. Small umbrella
- 9. Cli Bars or your favorite energy bars
- 10. Power bank
- 11. Universal adapter
- 12. If you're bringing an electronic from US/ Canada portable voltage converter
- 13. A small hook for behind the door for multiple purposes (to hang clothes etc)
- 14. Fragrance free wipes
- 15. Vaseline
- 16. Pocket sized tissue paper
- 17. A roll of toilet paper (in case some places do not have any)
- 18. Socks & Underwear for every day so you don't have to wash clothes as often.
- 19. Light travel towel (2)
- 20. Slippers
- 21. Comfortable walking shoes (we recommend slip on sneakers, bobs, etc.)

22. Slides or Flip Flops for Ihram for Men


Acceptable footwear must NOT have straps on the ankle and back of the heel.

<u>Examples of acceptable footwear</u> and ones we recommend in our Legacy Fiqh acceptance. Some in the Hanafi madhab prefer that the top of the foot show so if you wish to follow that all the "thong" style slippers are fine.

Please get these before Hajj and wear them in otherwise you will have cha ng if they're brand new.




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EXAMPLES OF FOOTWEAR THAT IS **NOT ALLOWED** FOR MEN TO WEAR IN IHRAM



- 23. Toothpaste, toothbrush, miswak, floss/ toothpicks
- 24. Travel comb
- 25. Toiletry bag that has a handle to hang if needed
- 26. Razor and shaving cream
- 27. Small scissors
- 28. Nail clippers
- 29. Q-Tips
- 30. Chapstick
- 31. Small mirror especially if it has suction cups to hang on a wall or hook
- 32. Hand sanitizer (spray and/ or liquid)
- 33. Wipes (sanitizing and disinfecting) fragrance free
- 34. Sunscreen fragrance free
- 35. Soap (liquid or bar) fragrance free
- 36. Shampoo, Conditioner, Body Wash Travel Size
- 37. Face & Body Lotion a few can be unscented to use during Ihram
- 38. Deodorant get 2: one that is unscented for when in ihram
- 39. Diary/ Notebook
- 40. Eid clothes
- 41. Sunglasses
- 42. Prayer rug

- 43. Money
- 44. Unlocked phone (if it doesn't have dual SIM, get a cheap second unlocked phone)
- 45. Travel pillow
- 46. Alcohol wipes
- 47. Small light string bag
- 48. Backpack
- 49. Travel iron if you absolutely need it
- 50. Ziplock bags
- 51. Small bags for necessities
- 52. Bags for dirty clothes (we found a few medium size garbage bags work great and can carry heavy loads)
- 53. Luggage: Small Roller Carry On, 1 to 2 Large / Medium Luggage as needed
- 54. Muzdalifah Specific: Small inflatable pillow if you don't want to use your travel pillow, light linen and cotton blanket to sleep on. We do NOT recommend sleeping bags as it is very hot and they are polyster made. Imagine packing camping and having light but breathable and thick enough but packable material. You can also put it over your prayer mat for giving you more cushioning

IHRAM – 2 Ihram's is good. You can always buy them when you arrive to Makkah/ Madinah, but if you want to buy in advance 2 is fine. They come in more than one size. We recommend the following brands as they are very lightweight and breathable, otherwise whatever is comfortable is fine. Stay away from heavy polyster as it will make you sweat a lot. You can alternatively make your own ihram by buying the material and cutting it out from places like Michael's or other fabric stores. Again, please make sure the fabric is breathable.





Keep in mind it's summer in Saudi it's hot! Get light clothing

If you forget to pack something from home, there is a store in Bin Dawood and Pharmacies that have these things (especially the linen for Muzdalifah or travel iron for example).

This is just a suggested list, you may need more or less of what's on this list according to each individual's needs.
